Description:

The building is one of (2) four-story brown glass buildings, separated by a fountain. We are located off the East driveway of the building on the third floor. The building is wheel-chair accessible.



Flying In and Light Rail:

We are located a 20-minute drive from Phoenix International Sky Harbor Airport. Follow directions from the South. A Light Rail System runs past the airport and stops ½ block from our campus. The cost to ride is about \$1.25 one way. A free shuttle connects the airport to the light rail system. From the North:

Take I 17 South. Exit Camelback Road and head East. Our building is on the right (South Side) of the street one block before the intersection with 19th Avenue. The parking lot is on the East side of the buildings.

From the South:

Take I-10 North. Exit I-10 on I-17 heading North. Exit Camelback Road and head East. The building is on the right (South Side) of the street in one block before the intersection with 19th Avenue. The parking lot is on the East side of the buildings.

From the East:

Take US 60 heading West. Exit US 60 on I-10 heading North. Exit I-10 on I-17 heading North. Exit Camelback Road and head East. The building is on the right (South Side) of the street in one block before the intersection with 19th Avenue. The parking lot is on the East side of the buildings.

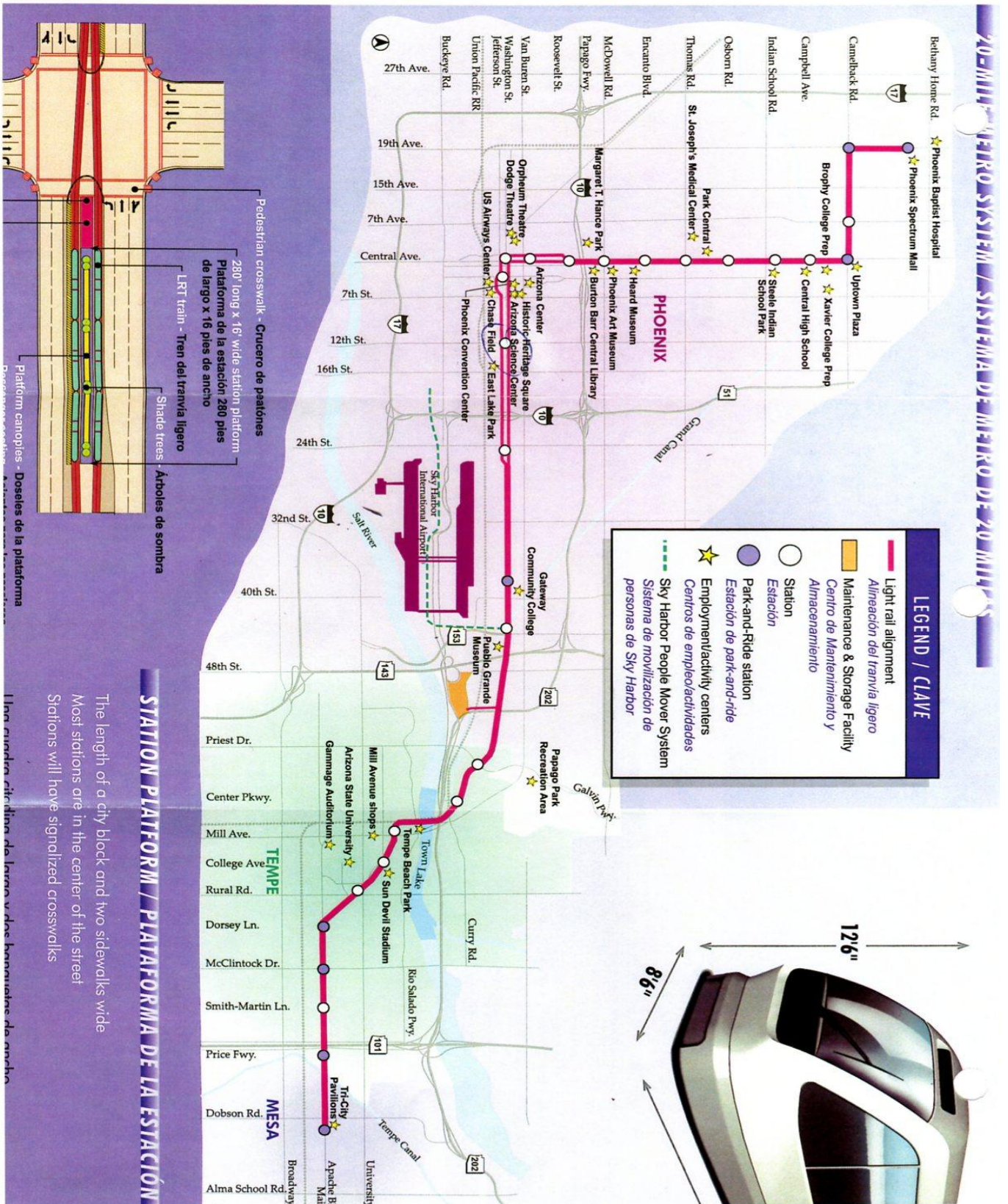
From the West:
